As of March 31st, the Kiwanis Administrative year is officially half over. Now would be an excellent time to evaluate if your club is on track to earn Distinguished Club Honors for 2006-2007. You can download a copy of the 2006-2007 Distinguished Club Criteria from:

You will want to look under **Distinguished Club/Division** and click on **Criteria Information 06-07**.

Perhaps the easiest points to accumulate for the Distinguished Club award are for making a minimum \$5.00 per capita donation (\$100.00 minimum) to the **Annual Club Giving Campaign** of the **Kiwanis International Foundation**. You can check the status of your club's 2006-2007 giving to the Foundation at <http://kif.kiwanis.org/kif/giving/acgreport.asp> and clicking on Pacific Northwest District. Then - simply scroll down in the report to your Division and club.
