NEW MONTHLY REPORTING SYSTEM STARTS IN OCTOBER

As mentioned above, the District Board of Trustees has voted to use the OMR Online Reporting system created by Club Resource, LLC., beginning October 1. One of the major reasons for this change is that the program, named the **KiwanisONE Online Reporting System**, is fully supported by Kiwanis International. Many portions of the system have been, and are, being integrated with the computer systems at Kiwanis International. For instance, in addition to filing your Official Monthly Report online, club secretaries in the PNW will now be able to file other required reports online as well. The Annual Report of Club Election is already integrated into the program for next year – and we expect several other reports to be added soon!

There are two parts to the KiwanisOne system. The first is the **Online Club Reporting System** which will be free to every club in the District. The second is the **KiwanisOne Portal** – a Kiwanis Club management system. Use of the management system will be fee based – and like most things in Kiwanis, the annual software lease will be based on the size of the club.

Scott Smith, the developer of the KiwanisOne software, will be with us in Tacoma to introduce these exciting new club administrative tools and provide training on both systems. If there was ever a Kiwanis District Convention to make certain that your incoming club secretary attends, this is the one!
