

ELECTION REPORTS ARE PAST DUE

Clubs were required to file the 2008-2009 Annual Report of Club Election by June 1st. For the first time, club secretaries are now able to do so online using the KiwanisOne Reporting System - the same system used to file your Official Monthly Report.

Filing the Annual Club Election Report is easy and a lot faster than filling out and mailing a hard copy of the form. Secretaries may easily indicate the incoming officers using convenient drop-down menus. If needed, secretaries also have the opportunity to correct the mailing address and other contact information for their incoming officers. However, if all of the incoming officer's information is correct, there is absolutely no need to enter it all again! What a time saver - both for the club secretary and for the staff at Kiwanis International and the District Office.

As of June 16th, we still need online reports from 155 clubs - forty-two (42) percent of the clubs in the District!

Some clubs may have filed their Club Election Report with Kiwanis International or the District Office by sending in a hard copy - rather than filing on-line. That is perfectly fine and your information will be received and used. However, as Kiwanis International will not be starting to enter the data received via hard copy reports into their database until later in the summer, we want to encourage those clubs to please go back and report your election results online in the KiwanisOne system, if at all possible. This will save your staff many, many hours of data entry time that could be used for a more productive Kiwanis use and also cut down on the inevitable errors that creep in during the data entry process.

Registration materials for the 91st District Convention, to be held in Kennewick, Washington the weekend of August 14-17, 2008 are now available on the District website at <http://www.pnwikiwanis.org/PNWKIResources/kennewickfiles.html> . A hard copy is also included as a special insert to the Spring 2008 issue of The Builder which is at the printers now.

The Kennewick Host Committee has prepared a full and fun filled weekend and you are all invited! Don't miss the Kick-off Luncheon with Kiwanis World Service Medal Recipient Dr. Lew Zirkle or the Governor's Banquet with Past Kiwanis International President Steve Siemens as the featured speaker. You'll also have the opportunity to take a boat cruise on the mighty Columbia River or explore the Wine Country surrounding the Tri-Cities area.

As of June 19th, there are two proposed Bylaws amendments on the agenda for the House of Delegate session. The first, submitted by the District Board of Trustees, would raise the subscription price of The Builder magazine by one dollar beginning October 1, 2008. This would also have the effect of raising District per capita dues by one dollar.

The second proposed Bylaw amendment is submitted by the Kiwanis Club of Greater Tacoma and would eliminate the age 30 limit on the District Dues Waiver given to former Service Leadership Program members when they join Kiwanis. Kiwanis International eliminated their age limit a year or two ago and this will bring the District Bylaws into conformity with those of International - thus cutting down on the potential for confusion created by the variance.
